★ **Some ways to cherish and celebrate this vital relationship:**

Go outside and INHALE the many scents and aromas that you find waiting for you. Breathe in the beauty. Taste and see that God is GOOD and so are YOU.

What thoughts, feelings, perceptions did you experience?

★ Create something if you feel so moved. Write a poem or draw the experience if this appeals to you or tell someone what happened to you. **Plant a small bush, a tree or some flowers in your yard.**

Take a walk in the dark and rely on your ears and nose to experience nature.

★ Sit in silence inside or outside. Breathe in deeply and fully . . . gently slow down . . . let all barriers dissolve . . . inhale and let the flow of your breath fill the universe . . . in and out, in and out . . . praise the God of life . . . in and out . . . let the experience evolve . . .

★ Take off your shoes, walk in the grass, on the ground, getting your feet dirty and hands too. What was it like?

★ Recall all the places that matter to you. What one matters most? Get in touch with why it is special for you, its importance to you. Find a photo or take a photo, or draw a picture of that place. Share with someone what it is you are willing to do to protect what is special to you, what you love and why. **Plan a gathering of people in your community to attend *An Inconvenient Sequel: Truth to Power* in theaters July 28th.**

★ Plan a PICNIC, go for a HIKE, organize a CLEAN UP.

Make a list of 5 elements in the natural world that you enjoy. Invite someone to prepare a similar list. Have a get together over a cup of tea or coffee, a glass of wine or water, or go for a walk and share the lists. Explore the value and meaning these elements to you. Meet a second time and invite a third person to create and bring their list as they join you in a new experience.

The traditional Christian interpretation of Pentecost implies that the arrival of the Holy Spirit was not something that occurred until Jesus' died, what John calls "the glorification of Jesus". One can get the impression that the breath of God was absent in the universe, and then was introduced only after Jesus' death.

WHAT'S
NEW

But, of course, in an evolutionary worldview, the evolutionary current by which all levels of reality, including the first atoms after the Big Bang, transcend themselves, and unify into a greater, unified whole (helium and hydrogen forming galaxies, for example) is itself what the tradition has named the Holy Spirit, or the breath of God implicate in the process of creation itself. This developmental process, by which parts are unified into more complex wholes, and then the wholes themselves become parts of ever-larger and more complex wholes, is what I define as salvation—the wholification of the cosmos. The history of salvation, then, extends to the entire universe. Salvation in this sense includes, but is not limited to, the human domain. We too are in the process of being saved, or wholified. This implies that we are whole, but also just parts of a new whole, the new human, that wants to emerge.

IMAGINE Imagine what we can bring about if we conspire, ("conspirare" to breathe together) if we breathed together and listened together for the rushing wind? What might we might bring about? What would we discover? Spend time with others in such a "conspiracy" and let us know what happened.

The Pentecostal power, as presented in both Acts 2:1-2, John's gospel, and in the Numbers 11:24-30 passage is one of the power to communicate, with directness and immediacy, the good news that we are in the process of being made whole (saved) by a Love which is our destiny.

When evolution is interpreted theologically or spiritually, we must say that it is not an emergence of the higher from the lower. Rather, it represents the presence of the higher, the divine life and impulse, already enfolded into earlier forms of life, and when the time and conditions are ripe, the flowering of implicate or latent potential emerges. Life, in other words, is enfolded like a seed, within inorganic matter. Consciousness is enfolded, like a seed, within life. The moral impulse for love and justice, are enfolded, like seeds, within consciousness. And, to get to the Pentecostal point of all this, the new human is enfolded, seed-like, within the existent human. Salvation, then, is the realization and revelation of God, through this evolutionary process of wholification.
