**Sister Beverly (Mary Evelyn) Reck, SSND**  
**Former teacher, principal and librarian**

**St. Louis** – Sister Beverly Reck, SSND, died Monday, July 24, 2017, at Veronica House in Bridgeton, Missouri. She was 79, and a former teacher, principal and librarian.

The funeral Mass was celebrated July 29 in the School Sisters of Notre Dame Theresa Center chapel in south St. Louis County. Burial was in the Sancta Maria in Ripa cemetery.

Sister Beverly was born in Hillsboro, Illinois. She entered the congregation of the School Sisters of Notre Dame in 1956. She professed first vows in 1958 and final vows in 1964.

She earned a bachelor's degree in history in 1960 from the former Notre Dame College in St. Louis and a master's in elementary administration in 1970 from St. Louis University.

Sister Beverly began her teaching career at Our Lady of Mount Carmel in Herrin, Illinois. This service was followed by positions at Our Lady of Mount Carmel in Houston, St. Hedwig in St. Louis and Holy Family in Freeburg, Missouri. She was a principal at Holy Family in Freeburg, Missouri; St. William in St. Louis; St. Hilary in Pico Rivera, California; St. Mary Magdalen in Brentwood, Missouri; and St. Mary School in Johnson City, Tennessee. She also served as an administrator at Notre Dame Hall in St. Louis and as a librarian at Blessed Sacrament in Belleville, Illinois.

She was missioned to Veronica House in 2014.

She has no immediate survivors.
