Sister Rita is director of **Whole Health Outreach (WHO)** project, an ecumenical group of trained staff and volunteers. Sisters Cynthia and Rosanne participate in this ministry which serves a five-county area. Together, they are committed to preventive healthcare and education, responding to unmet needs that impact women, children, young families and the elderly. Resources and services include:

- Families-In-Crisis Network;
- Casa Guadalupe, a 24-hour residential facility offering support services to women and children;
- Survivors of domestic and sexual violence;
- Homeless and senior programs.

Sister Anne is the director of **Whole Kids Outreach (WKO)** that helps break transgenerational poor health and abuse for pregnant mothers and families with young children. Families are helped to:

- Obtain health care;
- Learn parenting skills;
- Network with community services;
- Participate in recreational and educational activities.
