A LENTEN RETREAT ON PRAYER

TAKE OFF YOUR SHOES, FOR THE PLACE WHERE YOU STAND ISHOLY GROUND.Exodus 3:5

THIRD SUNDAY OF LENT

The Exodus passage in the first reading, describes a powerful experience of God as well as a revelation of God *as present*. The 'I AM WHO AM' has been translated by scholars as: *I am here, as I am here,* and has been described as the greatest revelation of the divine in the Hebrew Scriptures. The presence of God 'makes holy' and transforms all with the flames of love. The whole earth and all that has been created is *holy ground,* so we walk barefoot in respect and awareness of God's presence.

Meeting the Divine in our own lives is also a 'burning bush' experience, an experience of God's nearness and love.

LIVING THE THIRD WEEK

- 1. When you pray this week, take off your shoes remembering that 'where you are' is holy ground.
- 2. Remember your own 'burning bush experiences.
- 3. Make holy your everyday space. God is always present, and always 'burning' with love. If you need to: 'fertilize that space' by creating a prayerful and beautiful place to pray, reflect and read.
- 4. Fertilize your interior space by good spiritual reading.

SCRIPTURE READINGS

Exodus 3:1-8, 13-155 1Cor. 10:1-6, 10-12 Luke 13:1-9
