Retreat Center Features


- Walking path around 75 acres of prairie

Directions

Option 1 - from the north (Hwy. 30) Take Hwy. 30 west to Wheatland. Go south on County Rd. Y4E or 130th Ave. for 1.5 miles. Turn left on to 257th St., a gravel road. Go 2 miles to #2664. Turn right into the driveway.

Option 2 - from the south (I80) Take I80 to Walcott/Plainview Exit. Head north toward Dixon (8 miles). At the T intersection in Dixon, turn left onto Y4E or 130th Ave. 2.5 miles to Big Rock. Turn right on to 278th (gravel) go 1 mile and turn left onto 145th Ave. Go 3/4 of a mile to #2664. Turn left into driveway.
