"It is a natural tendency to come to God saying something like, 'Dear God, I've been offered this wonderful new job. I think I should take it. Don't you?' We expect to hear resounding agreement to a question stated like that, and we often close our ears to anything that sounds like no. But in discernment, we come before God with a hearing heart and say that we are faced with a new opportunity; we ask if it is consistent with God's desires. And then we wait, with both expectancy and patience, for guidance. Or at least we try...if we wish to know what God desires rather than what we think should happen, we need to spend at least some of our prayer time holding the world and our specific concerns before God without an agenda..."
